

Lesson 12: Follow the Pecks

Do together.

How do you think a woodpecker makes sounds? Explain that a woodpecker can peck about 10-20 times per second. It has a thick skull that protects its brain from the rapid pecking motion.

Give children two blocks and encourage them to explore making sounds. (Can also clap)

For Miss Marissa's Class: for a challenge- say your name and encourage the child to tap their blocks (or clap) along with each syllable in that name. Repeat with other names.

Example: Ha-noon (two claps), Al-Zain-a (three claps)
